BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council this 21<sup>st</sup> day of August, 2012, that the 1998 Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, South Carolina, Chapter

## Sec. 6-6. Time of elections; notice.

- (a) Elections for city officials shall be held in odd numbered years on the first Tuesday following the first Monday in November.
- (b) The council shall give public notice of the general city election at least 90 days prior to the date of the election.

## Sec. 6-7. Time of taking office; contested elections.

- (a) Newly elected officers shall not be qualified pursuant to state law until January 1 next following the date of the general election.
- (b) If the results of the election are contested, the incumbent who fills that contested office shall hold over until the contest is finally determined.
